☆ **Staining & Sealers/Coatings** **February 26, May 20**

This class explains the three major stain types (acid, water based and acetone based), the advantages of each, when and where to use them, and in what sequence they may be used. The Sealer and Coating segment discusses the differences between sealers and coatings looking at strengths of each, as well as where and how to use them. Useful efflorescence and moisture mitigation information is shared.

☆ **Stamping** **April 9, May 7, June 18**

This class teaches you knowledge of mix designs and admixtures in order to maximize both productivity of the placement and the long term durability of the concrete. The labor savings and the durability advantages of making monolithic pours and how to accomplish this is also discussed. Coloring methods are shown as well as important reinforcement tips.

☆ **Vertical** **April 23, June 25**

Learn the art of rock waterfalls and tree making along with stucco veneers. Emphasis on building armatures and substrate preparation as well as coloring methods.

☆ **Overlays** **January 22, April 30, June 4**

Surface preparation and choosing the correct product for a particular application are important areas discussed. Coloring and sealer/coating choices are explained and explored.

☆ **Countertops & Advance Forming** **January 15, March 5, May 14, June 11**

This class will teach the versatility of concrete as a countertop, table, shelving, back splash, base board, fireplace surround, sink and sealer material both in cast-in-place and pre-cast methods. Coloring, reinforcement and coatings are explored as well as polishing and special effects.

☆ **One Day Floors** **February 19, April 16, May 21**

This class emphasizes the importance of floor forensics, surface preparation, and proper selection of the One Day Floor systems to meet specific project conditions. The One Day Floor's Moisture Mitigating system is explained and how it reduces vapor transmission of more than 10 pounds to less than 2 pounds. Learn how to properly apply this versatile material.

☆ **Acid Staining Class for Women** **April 17**

This class is all about the smarter and easier ways to acid stain beautiful floors. This class is taught by women and attended by women.
